Get your blood test results

How Long Will It Take For My Results To Come Back?

The length of time it takes for results to come back to us varies depending on what types of tests are being done. In most cases results will come back to us within 3 to 7 days.

How Do I Find Out My Results?

If your results have come back **abnormal** and follow up action is needed we will contact you. If this is urgent then you will be contacted by phone whenever possible. If the follow up action is not urgent then you may be contacted by phone or by letter.

If your results come back **normal**, all you need to do is phone us up whenever is convenient and ask the receptionist for the results.

If a result has come back abnormal it does not always mean that there is anything to worry about, or that urgent action is needed.

Receiving Results by Text Message

If you are signed up for our text messaging service we may send a message when your results arrive.

Please also note that if several tests were requested at the same time these will come back to us separately, and you may receive separate text messages for each.

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What Do My Results Mean?

Your results will be interpreted by a GP and filed in one of the following categories;

Normal: This means that the tests have not shown anything wrong.

Satisfactory: This means that whilst your results may be slightly outside the normal range, these are entirely to be expected given your age or medical history. No alteration in management is required.

Borderline: This means that one or more of the results has come back very close to the limit of what we would consider 'normal'.

Abnormal: This means that one or more of your results has come back higher or lower than what we would consider 'normal'.

Abnormal but expected: This means that one or more of your results has come back higher or lower than what we would consider 'normal', but that these results are what the GP expected to see based on your medical history.

In addition to this the doctor may add a comment to your result.

Our reception team are not trained to interpret your results and will only relay the information given by the doctor. If you would like a more detailed explanation of the results please book a routine telephone appointment with a doctor.

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
